- **7.** Tom Hollis made a motion to approve the EADS Group as the 2018 GVMA Engineer. Leo Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Rick Gates, Tom Roles, Peggy Lidwell, and Tracy Plessinger voted nay. Motion Failed.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve Keller Engineers as the 2018 GVMA Engineer. Peggy Lidwell seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Hollis voted nay. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineers. All other board members voted aye. Motion passed.

Several customers are having pressure issues on Church Hill. Once the extension is complete, GVMA will replace a section of Randy Westover's pecs line that was cut for installation of the pump. Tom Hollis seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineers. All other board members voted aye. Motion passed.
- B. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the Operator's Report. Tom Roles seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.

A. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the Engineer's Report. Leo Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.

New Business

- A. Peggy Lidwell made a motion to enter executive session at 8:08 p.m. to discuss personnel/legal matters. Leo Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- B. Tom Roles made a motion to exit executive session at 8:35 p.m. to discuss personnel/legal matters. Peggy Lidwell seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- C. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve January receipts in the amount of \$140,206.74 and disbursements in the amount of \$118,089.09. Peggy Lidwell seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineers. All other board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- D. Tom Roles made a motion to approve the December Treasurer's Report showing a balance of \$66,274.54. Leo Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present vote aye. Motion passed.
- E. Peggy Lidwell made a motion to approve Keller Engineer's proposal of \$5,000.00 for the completion of the 2017 GVMA Annual Reports. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineer's. All other board members voted aye. Motion passed.
- F. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the water purchase agreement with RTMA as follows:
 - 1. Term of the agreement will be 20 years to coincide with the RTMA PennVest Project and term of the loan funding.
 - 2. Bulk water purchase rate will remain at \$5.00 per 1,000 gallons for year one of the agreement .
 - 3. GVMA is permitted to explore and develop other sources of water if it chooses to during the term of the agreement with a 2 year advanced notice to RTMA. GVMA is not exclusive to purchasing water from RTMA.
 - 4. Minimum water delivery requirements pertaining to water pressure and volume will be determined by the engineers and included as part of this agreement. The only time these requirements would not be met is during emergency situations such as waterline breaks, equipment failures, etc...
 - 5. GVMA will get a capped 2% rate increase each year for the duration of the agreement.

Peggy Lidwell seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Hollis abstained. All other board members voted aye. Motion passed.

General Public Comment

- A. Jim Thompson explained the reason that RTMA didn't agree to the 2% capped water rate increase. RTMA would like the GVMA rate increase to be the same as the increase they set for their other customers.
- B. Tom Hollis would like John to take a look at the Ronald Schnetza property in Blandburg. He is having an issue with freezing lines.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 p.m. Peggy Lidwell seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members voted aye. Motion passed.
